Characteristics of Specialty Medications

Specialty medications are defined as high-cost oral or injectable medications used to treat complex chronic conditions. These are highly complex medications, typically biology-based, that structurally mimic compounds found within the body. High-touch patient care management is usually required to control side effects and ensure compliance.

Specialized handling and distribution are also necessary to ensure appropriate medication administration. Medications must have at least one of the following characteristics to be classified as a specialty medication managed by Fred Hutch Specialty Pharmacy.

High Cost

High-cost medications are typically priced at more than \$1000 per 30-day supply, including self-administered injectables, professionally administered injectables/infusions, and oral medications

High Complexity

- Biotechnology products
- Orphan or Ultra-Orphan drugs
- Medications that are included in a specialty therapeutic drug class strategy

High Touch

- Medications that require temperature control or other special handling/shipping requirements (e.g., refrigerated or frozen shipping)
- Medications that require ongoing drug management by a pharmacist and/or physician specializing in treating a patient's condition
- Medications that require focused, in-depth education, compliance monitoring, side effect management, and, often, injection technique education
